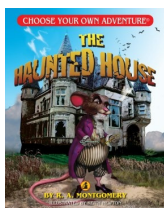

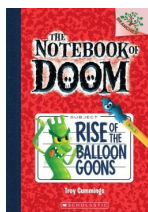

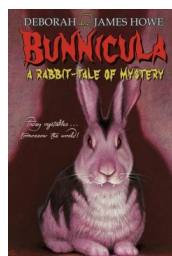


## Scary Stories to Tell in the Dark

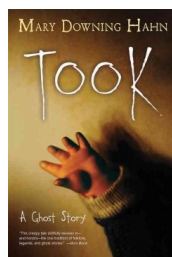


## Bunnicula: A Rabbit-Tale of Mystery

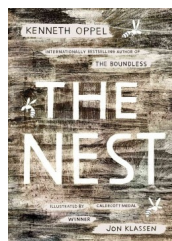


## Took: a Ghost Story

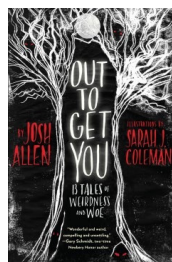


## The Nest

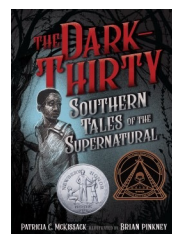

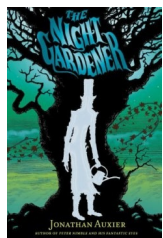


## Thriller

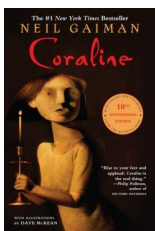


## The House with a Clock in its Walls

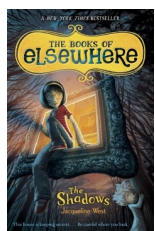


## Coraline

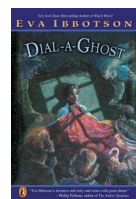


## Revenge of the Witch

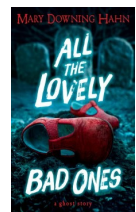


## Serafina and the Black Cloak

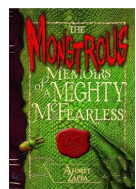


## All the Lovely Bad Ones : A Ghost Story
