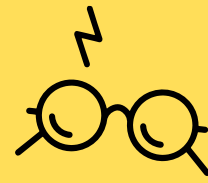

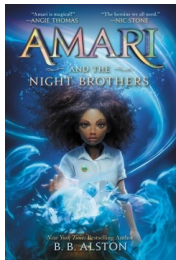


The Manifestor Prophecy

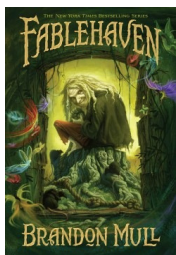


Amari and the Night Brothers

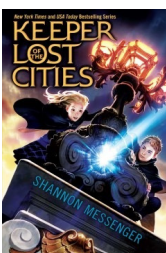


Fablehaven

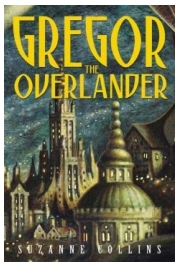
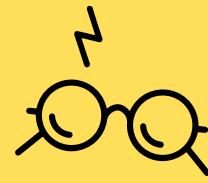

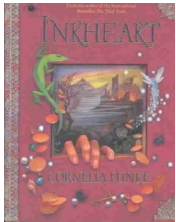


Gregor the Overlander

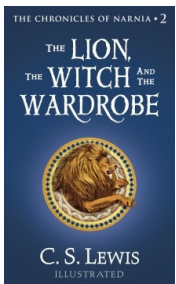


Inkheart

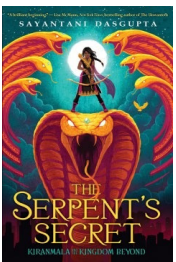


The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe

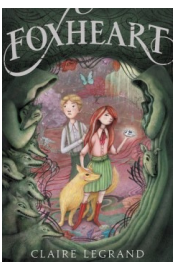
The Serpent's Secret
