- **PEPPERS:** Chinese Giant, Poblano, Habanero, Hot Early Jalapeno, Jalapeno Emerald Fire, Hatch, Golden Cal Wonder, Chinese Giant, Cornito, and Majestic Red.
- **VEGETABLES:** Cucumbers: Lemon, Marketmore, Spacemaster 80 and Homemade Pickle. Summer Squash: Cocozelle, Romanesco, Cube of Butter, Dirani, Early Prolific Straightneck, Max's Gold, Jaune of Verte, and Scallop Blend. Winter Squash: Butternut and Vegetable Spaghetti. Watermelon: Crimson sweet and Sugar Baby. Pumpkin: Howden, Jack O'Lantern, Jarrahdale and Lumina.
- **SUCCULENTS:** Many varieties to choose from.
- **HOUSEPLANTS:** Pothos, Sanseveria cylindrica, Trailing Jade, Portulacaria Afra and others planted in ceramic pots.
- **PLUMERIA:** Potted and rooted in 2022 plus cuttings.
- **FLOWERS:** Bachelor Buttons, Cosmos, Marigold, Scabiosa, Shasta Daisy, Snap Dragon, Tithonia, Zinnia, Amaranth, Lupine, and Johnny Jump Up.
- **DEMONSTRATIONS:** Make a succulent arrangement. Grow a succulent from a leaf or cutting. Prepare a cutting to plant. Children can pot a succulent leaf cutting.
- **EMERGING TREE PESTS:** Learn about the Citrus Psyllid and Huanglongbing, a disease causing large areas in OC to be quarantined. Learn about the beetles that are destroying thousands of trees in Orange County. Learn how to recognize them and what you need to do. See close up what the beetles look like.
- **LEARN ABOUT:** Vermiculture (worms) Red wigglers available for purchase.
- **COMPOSTING:** How to make your own fertilizer for your garden.
